*Account numbers must be eight digits. If your number has less than eight digits, add zeros to the beginning of the number until it reaches eight digits

Where can I find my Checking (Share Draft) Account Number?

If you have checks, your Account Number is the eight digit number at the bottom of the check located to the right of our routing number.

Or if you have access to CU Online or our mobile app, log in and click on the name of your Share Draft account. Then click on "Account Details" (in CU Online) or "Show Details" (in the mobile app). The Account Number is listed as MICR. Please note that all Share Draft Account Numbers should be eight digits. If your MICR number is shorter than eight digits, add zeros (0) in front until it reaches eight digits (e.g. 123456 would need to be 00123456).

Where can I find my Savings (Primary Share) Account Number?

If you want your direct deposit to go to your Primary Share Savings Account, simply use your Member Number as the Account Number. This number can be up to ten digits and there is no need to add leading zeros.
